\$50 Fundraising Minimum

All participants 18 years of age and over are required to individually fundraise a minimum of \$50. This is in addition to the \$50.00 registration fee. Participants who do not raise the minimum will not be allowed to participate in future Winter Pineapple Classic events. The fundraising deadline is **December 1, 2014.** It is our promise to you to enforce this minimum, to further the cancer curing advances of the LLS mission.

Location & Parking

The event is held at Mountain Meadows Farm (10106 422nd Lane SE, North Bend, WA 98045). Parking for all vehicles is \$5.00, please carpool and have cash available. If you paid for parking upon registering for the event, your name will be on a list at the parking entry. This accounts for 1 car. Please see <u>venue map</u> for further details.



Registration, T-Shirts, & Bag Check

Registration, Check-In, T-Shirt Pick-Up, and Bag Check will all be held in the "Small Barn" on event day. Please see <u>venue map</u> for further details. This will open at 8:00AM. **Donations can be made via cash, check and credit card only at Registration**. We will be accepting day-of-event registration at \$65 per participant. T-Shirts have been ordered according to the size that you requested upon registering, there will be no swaps on event day.



Pre-Race Packet Pick-Up

Pre-race packet pick up will be held at Road Runner Sports in Seattle on Friday, November 7 from 11:00AM to 7:00PM. You can retrieve the packets for your own teammates, but not for other individuals. Each person gets

only one packet, so do not lose them. T-Shirts will not be available until event day. For every person that picks up a packet, Road Runner Sports will donate \$1.00 to the Leukemia & Lymphoma Society mission - if you are able, please help us further our fundraising for blood cancer cures and pick up at their location! Your pack may NOT be at Road Runner Sports if you registered after Monday, November 3, and can be picked up on the day of the event at Registration and Check-In.



Luau & Beer Garden

Food and beer will open at 9:30AM. Each participant has 1 luau ticket (food ticket) per registration, and this will be marked on your race bibs. If you purchased extra luau tickets when registering online, your name will be on a list at the start of the food line. If you want extra luau tickets on event day, anyone can purchase them for \$5.00 - but be sure to bring cash, no credit cards will be accepted at the luau line! While the beer is free, contributions to LLS are graciously accepted. Donation/Tip boxes will be located in the beer garden. The beer garden will be for participants 21 years of age and older. We will be checking ID's, so be sure to bring your wallets - **NO ID, NO SERVICE.**



Weather & Safety

It is our goal to see everyone have fun, get dirty, and help save lives. Our events are rain or shine! Be sure to dress and pack accordingly. We want to make certain everyone is safe on event day - if you think you cannot complete an obstacle, simply walk around it and continue on the race course. We will have medical staff on-site.



Timing Chips

All timing chips must be worn on the **TOP** of your **LEFT SHOE**, and should stick upwards. The chip will be cut off at the finish line. For any lost or unreturned chips, the participant will be charged \$30.00.
