Since 2017, an incredible 54 drugs for blood cancer received FDA approval—47 of them advanced with support from LLS and our donors. Right now, the pace of progress is moving at a historic pace, with the U.S. Food & Drug Administration (FDA) approving more drugs for blood cancer than ever before.

## 2. THE POWER OF YOUR DONATION



- \$25 helps fund an episode of The Bloodline with LLS, a free podcast series that provides information to patients and caregivers.
- \$50 helps fund educational booklets for healthcare providers and their patients.
- \$100 helps fund the training of Patti Robinson Kaufmann First Connection Program
   volunteers, who provide peer support to patients and their families around the country.
- \$200 helps fund general lab supplies for one week, allowing researchers funded by The Leukemia & Lymphoma Society to conduct critical blood cancer research.
- \$300 helps fund one week of an online support group on www.LLS.org for patients and caregivers coping with a blood cancer diagnosis.
- \$500 provides financial assistance for non-medical expenses, including rent or mortgage, utilities, dependent care, food and car repairs, related to treatment to a pediatric or young adult patient, or an adult patient enrolled in a clinical trial, through our Urgent Need Program, established in partnership with Moppie's Love.
- \$1,000 helps fund one day of nurses providing patients and caregivers with clinical trial search navigation and support through The Leukemia & Lymphoma Society's Clinical Trial Support Center.
- \$1,000 helps support the training of a research fellow funded by The Leukemia & Lymphoma Society for one week.

## 3. LOCAL FUNDED RESEARCH



In the past 15 years, LLS has invested more than \$20 million in WA State cancer research. Last fiscal year alone, LLS committed: more than \$3.4 million locally to seven active research projects in WA & \$793,000 in direct support to 440 patients in WA & AK through our Co-Pay Assistance Program.
